Senior Privilege - Permission to Leave Campus

Dear Parent/Guardian:

Your student is requesting that SHS & CTC grant permission for him/her to be released from school during a period of time when they have a free block. Your student must meet the following conditions in order to be eligible for the senior privilege of leaving campus during the school day.

1. has earned 18.5 credits by the beginning of the school year (initials Mrs. Lucier) _____
2. is scheduled to earn sufficient # of credits to graduate in June of Senior year (initials Mrs. Lucier) _____
3. has successfully completed the NECAP testing, or will complete it during Senior year (initials Mrs. Smith) _____
4. is not on probation or sanction from the preceding quarter grades (initials Mrs. Lucier) _____
5. did not receive any major infractions (detentions, ISS/OSS) in the preceding quarter (initials Mrs. O'Brien) _____
6. _____ is scheduled for a free block during the school day.

Senior Privileges involve the following parameters:

1. Seniors may leave the building for that block of time when there is no scheduled class. If that student chooses not to do so on a given day, they will be expected to work in the library or cafeteria, **and not disrupt classes, or walk through the interior or about the exterior of the building.**
2. Seniors will sign in/out in the Main Office when arriving or departing from school.
3. Seniors are not allowed to leave the building for lunch unless the free 90 minute block includes their lunch or is adjacent to it (ex. 2nd block off & A Lunch OR C Lunch & 4th Block off)
4. Seniors earning this privilege will be issued a sticker to be placed on the outside of the agenda book. Seniors will be expected to have their agenda book with them during their free block.
5. Seniors who are 18 must comply with all school rules.
6. Seniors who leave school without permission will earn an in-school suspension and lose of senior privileges.
7. This privilege will be rescinded for cutting class, class failure or misbehavior; including transporting other students.
8. Guardians can also request the removal of a free block.
9. Fulfilled requirements necessary for all state and federal school testing. (ex. Smarter Balance, NAEP, MAPS)
10. Must attend Future Skills and Planning

Permission is granted **ONLY** with guardian approval & school officials.
